One of the simplest yet most effective ways to protect yourself? Pause.

Before you click, send, or share—take a moment. Scammers rely on urgency, fear, and deception. A moment of hesitation can save you from financial loss and identity theft.

When Should You Pause?

- If someone pressures you to act immediately.
 Scammers create urgency to stop you from thinking critically. If you feel rushed pause.
- If you receive an unexpected call, text, or email.
 Legitimate organizations won't ask for sensitive information out of the blue. If it's unexpected—pause.
- If you're asked to send money or gift cards.

Scammers often demand payment in ways that are hard to trace. If someone asks for untraditional payment—pause.

- If you're asked for personal or banking details.
 - Your Credit Union, government agencies, and reputable companies will never ask for sensitive information over email or text. If they do pause.
- If it sounds too good to be true.
 - A sudden lottery win, an unbelievable investment, or an easy job with big pay? If it feels unrealistic—pause.
- · If you're asked to download or install something.
 - Scammers use malware to steal your data. If someone asks you to install software or grant remote access—pause.
- · If you feel unsure.
 - Trust your instincts. If something doesn't feel right, take a step back and verify.
